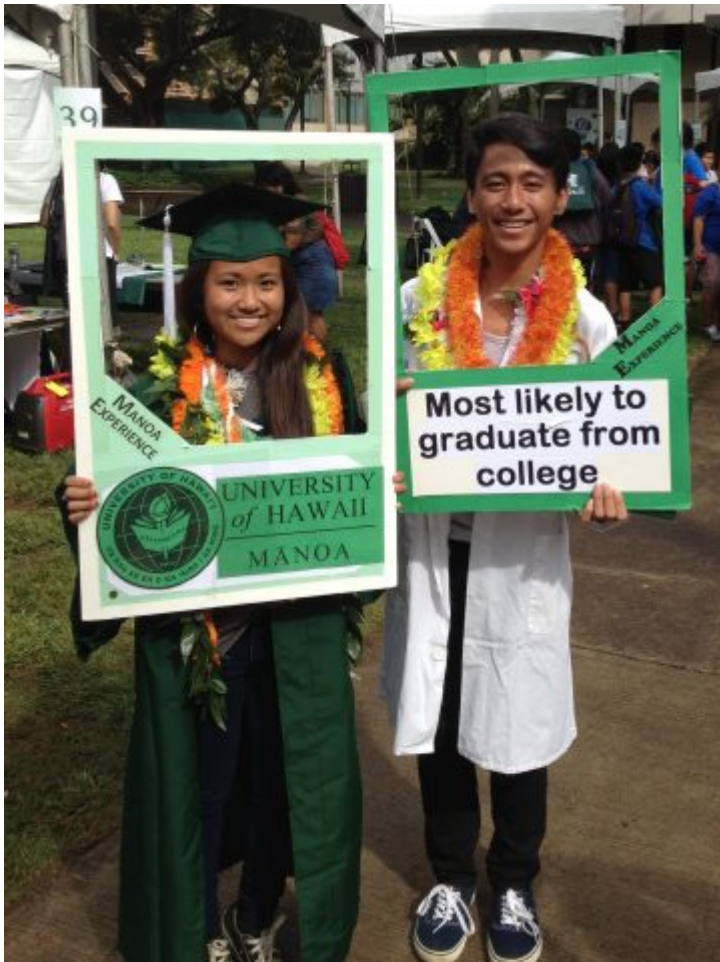


UH Manoa Experience Welcomes More than 1,400 Guests to Preview Day
